Compliance with WEEE Regulations

Reporting and Record-Keeping

We will maintain accurate records of WEEE generated, collected, and disposed of, ensuring transparency and compliance with reporting requirements. WEEE matters are addressed within our overarching Environmental, Social and Governance (ESG) plan, upon which regular reporting is delivered at Operating Board. ESG responsibilities are assigned, at Operating Board level, to the Chief People Officer.
